THE MAKING OF – A LOOK BEHIND THE SCENES

In mid-April, the steering committee of the SCORA initiative, led by Claudia Rugart, the director and initiator of SCORA, gets together at the State Center for Political Education in the Haus auf der Alb in Bad Urach for a two-day preparatory and introductory meeting. Key safety issues for young people are discussed and content and topics are exchanged with the workshop coordinators.

START OF SCORA MEET 2024

On Saturday, August 31, more than 200 young people and their accompanying teachers from Israel, India, the United States, and Baden-Württemberg arrive in Stuttgart, tired and happy.

The official welcome event takes place in the gym of the Friedrich-Eugens-Gymnasium in Stuttgart with all the young participants, their companions, and volunteers, as well as numerous guests of honor.

To fight jet lag and encourage a good sense of community, a large sports event is organized in the gym of the Friedrich-Eugens-Gymnasium. In mixed teams, the young participants compete in various games, balancing or moving around in the gym on small trolleys.

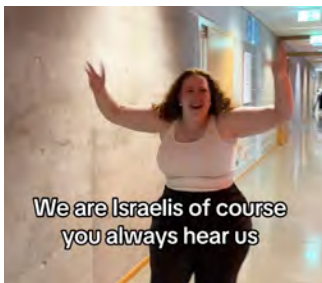

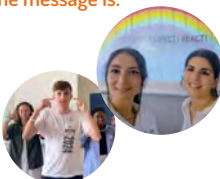
Trainers for intercultural communication are leading the “Respect Reflect React” workshop today: All young people take part in mixed groups. They talk about their preferences, their dreams, their fears, their concepts of foreignness and their everyday lives and thus learn intensively from each other and about their different cultures. Sensitive topics such as experiences of discrimination are also addressed. The knowledge acquired today provides the basis for the reflections that the participants will now carry out every evening in their small SCORA Family. The main questions are: How can I deal well with experiences of foreignness? How do I find my place? How do I strengthen others? How can we be different but still feel what unites us?

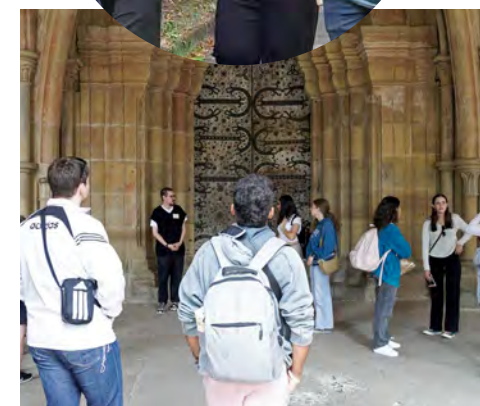

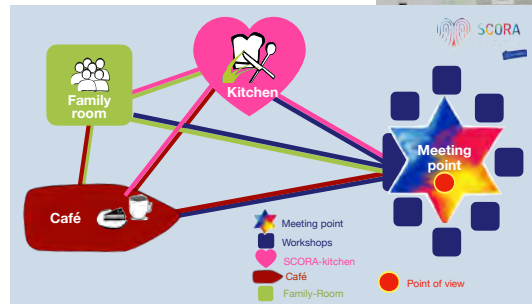
WELCOME TO OUR VIRTUAL SCORA WORLD

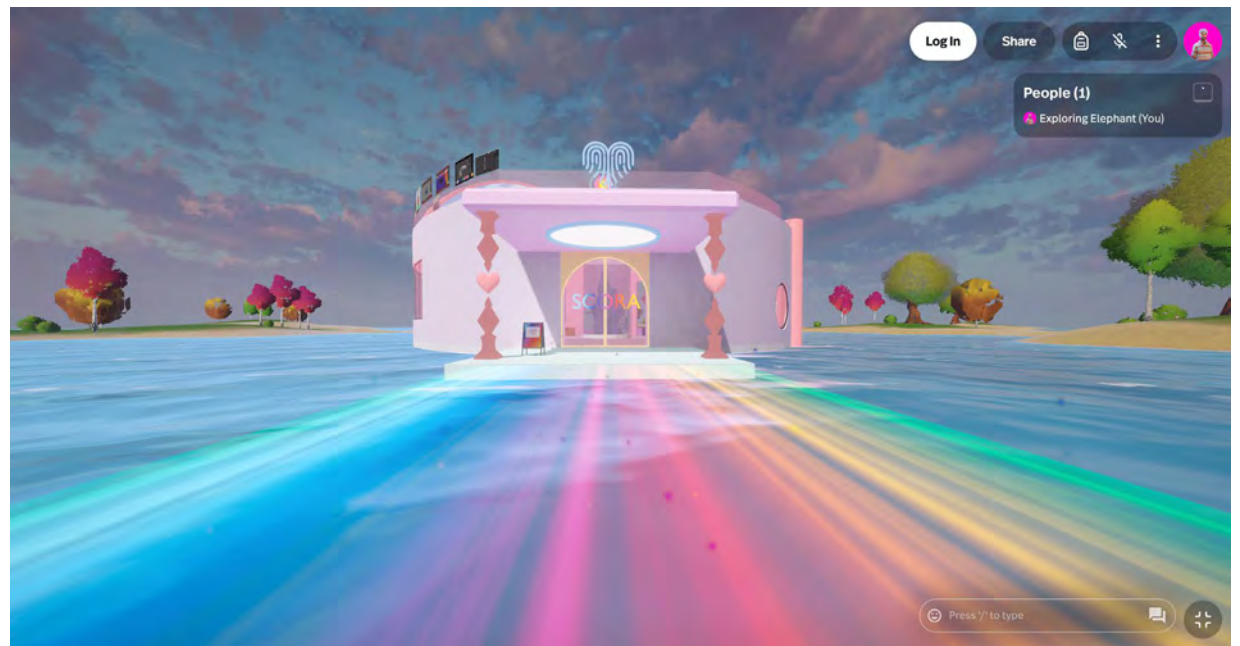

↑ Orientation plan of virtual SCORA World.



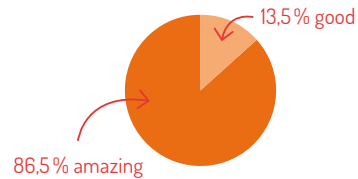

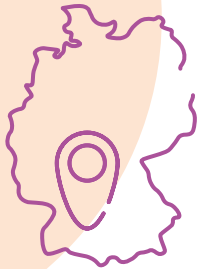

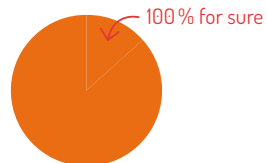

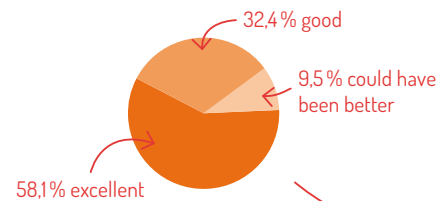

How was your workshop? *

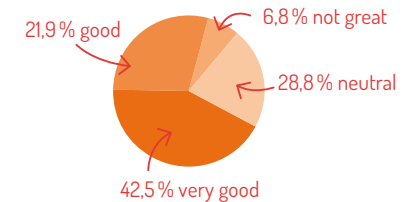

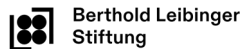
